St. John the Evangelist Wins IASP Math Bowl

ST. JOHN, Indiana-February, 23, 2017---St. John the Evangelist School's math team took first place in the Indiana Association of School Principals (IASP) Math Bowl Area Green Division. A selected group of fifth and sixth graders participated in the Math Academic Teams for Hoosiers (M.A.T.H.) competition on February 23rd, at St. Paul's in Valparaiso. Statewide, SJE tied for 7th place in Green Division among 128 other schools. Teams are selected by ISTEP and NWEA scores and an average of classroom grades.

St. John Evangelist's team consisted of 7 fifth graders and 9 sixth graders. The team completed 4 rounds, each with 8 questions, with the most points for the win. The competition is administered by IASP's Department of Student Programs, in order to emphasize the importance of mathematics in upper elementary grades.

Over 8,600 students, composing 563 teams, from grades 4, 5, and 6 from across the state competed in the 21st annual Math Academic Teams for Hoosiers (M.A.T.H. Bowl) competition. The 2017 M.A.T.H. Bowl Contest is the largest number of students ever involved in an Indiana Association of School Principals sponsored activity in the over 30 year history of Indiana Academic Competitions.
